Dear Sir,

Regarding the above premises application for a licence renewal for Entertainment Live and Recorded and the supply of alcohol.

We are residents of Spoor Street which is practically opposite the above named premises.

We have been in contact with Environmental Health on numerous occasions regarding these premises as sometimes the noise is unbearable, they have the side doors open (obviously letting more noise out of the building) people parking in Spoor Street and banging car doors at all hours of the night, urinating in the street, and back lane. Last week one chap was so drunk at 1.30 in the morning he was outside our house shouting on his mobile phone and when I asked him to keep the noise down I got a mouthful of abuse and he admitted he had just left the club. He slept in the car and drove off at 8AM after I had caught him urinating through our fence.

These premises also have tables outside where people sit drinking all day and getting louder as the day progresses making it impossible to enjoy our own outdoor space.

If they have more entertainment hours and sell alcohol for longer I can only see the situation getting much worse.

Gateshead Council are demolishing the maisonettes on Ravensworth Road and are planning to build new houses on this site, surely these new homes should be given some consideration when it comes to noise pollution and drunken behaviour on a daily basis. The regeneration of Ravensworth Road will never be a success unless something can be done to combat the noise, drunken behaviour and rubbish left lying around for the residents to clean up as the Council certainly forget that Dunston exists.
