12.08.17 Submitted to the Leader of the Council	09/17	Petition from residents of Robson Street, Low Fell	Petition regarding the condition of the tarmac pavement on Robson Street, Low Fell	Strategic Director, Communities and Environment	<p>The petition raised three issues - the condition of the footpath, the effect that the footpath breaking up was having in terms of piles of gravel, and gullies blocked with gravel from the footpath.</p> <p>The petitioners have been advised that officers will look at a resurfacing scheme for this area. However, at present they are unable to give an indication of the timescale.</p> <p>The area was inspected for any actionable defects (potholes exceeding 40mm in the road and trips in the footpath exceeding 20mm). The necessary repairs have been actioned.</p> <p>The street cleaning is on a 15 day rotation, extra visits are carried out upon request from the public for additional visits to pick up fallen leaves for example. The street has been swept and it will be monitored as a hot spot as until the</p>

					<p>footpath surface is renewed.</p> <p>A gully cleaning crew has attended the site to clear all gullies in the street. Parked cars have restricted the crew's access in some instances but it will continue to visit the area until they are all cleaned. The ward councillors have been notified of the above actions.</p> <p>It is proposed that the petition be removed from the schedule.</p>
