Mr P Pieri is making the application for a licence for the premises.

Since 2005 there have been a variety of companies claiming to be running the premises, however the application infers that there is a commonality throughout.

The effect of the companies is to accrue debt then dissolve, after which a new company takes over the property.

It is now more than 5 years since a payment was made directly to the council in respect of business rates for these premises.

Since 2005 the companies in occupation have systematically avoided paying the statutory business rates liability. This income is used to fund national services and local services as it is currently split 50/50 between Central Government and Gateshead Council. A breakdown of the balances that were lost to the taxpayer are as follows; -

The sustained non-payment of rates demonstrates that the 'various companies' who have registered for business rates have not been ran in a fit and proper manner. The council has made numerous efforts to discuss the payment of business rates and is willing and able to offer flexible payment arrangements in order to help any business to make affordable and sustainable payments, however, these efforts have been continually ignored. This demonstrates that there is and has been a continual absence of effective and responsible management of the premises.

Paragraph 5.1 of the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy states that 'Anyone who is or who seeks to be authorised under the Act to carry out licensable activities in the Borough of Gateshead should be aware of the other legislation, policies and guidance that may apply to their business. Failure to comply with other legislation and/or regulatory regimes can indicate that a licensee is irresponsible, which may call into question their ability to adequately promote the Licensing Objectives.'

It is clear that both the previous and current ratepayers of the premises have failed to comply with their obligations to pay business rates under the Local Government Finance Acts of 1988 and 1992 which demonstrates the irresponsible nature in which both the previous and current ratepayers have ran their business.

Evidence from the liquidator reports also indicates that debts were also accrued with HMRC. As such, the loss from the public purse contributes towards a reduction in the provision of governmental functions to support the community.

Gateshead Council Business Rates are now at the stage of making an application for the liquidation of Vinci Management Ltd and Magnum Hospitality Limited.
