The licence review reveals poor management of the premises and failure to promote and uphold the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder and the protection of children from harm, whilst under the control of the current premises licence holder Farhad JAMNEJAD.

The review was brought as a result of a test purchase exercise carried out at the premises on 24th February 2022, when a 15 year old child volunteer was sold a bottle of Desperados Beer without being prompted to show acceptable form of ID.
