Dear whom it may concern,

I am writing to OBJECT to the licensing application for the above property.

The Allerdene area has suffered from significant ASB in the last year which is only beginning to be tackled by a multi - disciplinary task force and the local community. Sadly this ASB is often caused by alcohol and I am very concerned that this would be a backwards step for the local community.

I am concerned that further availability of alcohol with have a negative affect on vulnerable persons and their families, and this is profiteering from the vulnerable.

In addition the property is adjacent to a local primary school and children's centre with a nursery for pre school children, where a number of vulnerable families attend themselves.
