Northumbria Police are concerned that the licensing objectives will become undermined should a new premises licence at 311-313 High Street be granted.

Northumbria Police are concerned that the licensing objectives will be undermined should the premises licence be granted.

In year 2015 the premises licence at these premises was revoked due to an underage sale of alcohol taking place. Mr Sajaad ALI was involved in the running of the premises at that time.

Mr ALI's application to become the licence holder and DPS at nearby premises 195 High Street, Gateshead was previously refused.

On 1st August 2019 whilst being the manager and working at Best One 201A Coatsworth Rd, Gateshead; Mr Sajaad ALI was involved in a violent incident at these premises.

The area where the premises are located already suffers alcohol related ASB and street drinking.

The application itself does not provide enough detail on what additional steps will be taken to promote the licensing objectives and in particular with respect to the proposed business model allowing the sale of alcohol until 3am.

It can be drawn from our previous experiences with Mr Ali and his management style, the locality itself and the lack of detail in the application that the grant of the premises licence will be detrimental to the said licensing objectives
