Good morning,

In relation to this application for a new premise licence **Northumbria Police object.**

The premises in question has just had its licence revoked because of the inability of the premises licence holder and the designated premises supervisor to ensure that the licensing objectives were being upheld.

On 19th August 2022 Northumbria Police placed an objection notice to a Temporary Event Notice submitted by the shop owner Mousa Mohammad Jaafar JAAFAR to permit alcohol sales at 170 Sheriffs Highway, Gateshead on 3rd & 4th September 2022 for which a licensing sub-committee hearing has been arranged for 31st August 2022.

To grant this application for a new premises licence and to specify Mousa Mohammad Jaafar JAAFAR as the Designated Premises Supervisor would undermine the licensing objective of not only prevention of crime and disorder but also protection of children from harm.
