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## **PURPOSE OF THE REPORT**

1. The Sub-Committee is asked to consider the application from Kiran Chippy Limited for a premises licence for Tony's Fish Bar, 275 High Street, Gateshead, NE8 1EP.

## **BACKGROUND**

### **The Application**

3. The application submitted by Kiran Chippy Limited ('Applicant') for a premises for Tony's Fish Bar, 275 High Street, Gateshead, NE8 1EP is attached at Appendix 1.

The application seeks:

Supply of Alcohol (off the premises)

Every Day 11:00 – 23:00

Late Night Refreshment

Friday and Saturday 23:00 – 00:00

The application was advertised at the premises and in the local press.

The Licensing Authority may attach conditions to any licence which are appropriate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives. A copy of the Model Pool of Conditions from Gateshead Council's Statement of Licensing Policy is attached as Appendix 1.2 that relate to the application.
