Premises Licence Application – Tony's Fish Bar, 275 High Street, Gateshead, NE8 1EP.

Having given consideration to the attached application, Northumbria Police are of the view that to grant a premises licence in this location and as presented in the application, would undermine the licensing objective of preventing crime and disorder. The rationale behind that is as follows:-

The area where the premises is located suffers from increased levels of anti-social behaviour including street drinking and associated crimes. We are aware that there is a Public Spaces Protection Order covering the area and to permit the sale of alcohol as an accompaniment to takeaway food will likely result in increased alcohol consumption in public spaces.

It is also noted that the application falls out with the Gateshead Council Statement of Licensing Policy.

Please accept this email as Northumbria Police objection to the application.
